KULETO 2016 ZINFANDEL, NAPA VALLEY

This month, we included two vintages of our Napa Valley Zinfandel for you to compare side by side. Our 2016 Zinfandel is a classic old world style; loaded with aromas of fresh blue fruits and strong notes of violet, followed by black pepper and a hint of vanilla. These aromas carry through to the palate with bright and juicy fruit flavors. Additional flavors of fresh plum intermingle with mild tannins and a subtle toastiness from the oak aging, leading way to a very even and long finish.

Composition: 95% Zinfandel, 4% Alicante Bouschet, 1% Petite Sirah
Aging: 16 months in 20% new Hungarian Oak 500L puncheons

KULETO 2017 ZINFANDEL, NAPA VALLEY

This month, we included two vintages of our Napa Valley Zinfandel for you to compare side by side. The 2017 vintage was a very warm year, which boasted wines with big fruit flavor, spice and juicy acidity. Our 2017 Zinfandel captures the essence of the year, and is loaded with spiced aromas of clove and cumin, followed by additional notes of plum and currant. The palate is dominated by flavors of black cherry and strawberry jam, with lingering savory notes of black olive, dried herbs and pepper on the finish.

Composition: 90% Zinfandel, 5% Alicante Bouschet, 5% Petite Sirah
Aging: 15 months in 20% new Hungarian oak 500L puncheons

KULETO 2016 EL COYOTE CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY

Wine lots and barrels selected for our 'El Coyote' Cabernet Sauvignon don't necessarily come from a particular spot on the estate, but rather share common flavor and structural attributes that highlight the dark, meaty, rich, black fruit aspects of the variety. To further highlight these characters, we often co-ferment with varieties that share these same qualities. You'll notice that there is a small percentage of Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Franc and Alicante Bouschet in our 2016.

The 2016 'El Coyote' Cabernet is about all things dark and powerful in a red wine. Dark blue-black fruit aromas tangle with those of darkly charred wood and blackened meat. It's very primal smelling. In the mouth, it lunges straight to the mid-palate then lurks under the tongue and coats the sides. If you like your Cabernet big, flavorful, and chewy, this is the one for you from the 2016 vintage.

Composition: 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Zinfandel, 5% Petit Syrah, 4% Pinot Noir, 3% Cabernet Franc, 3% Alicante Bouschet
Aging: 18 months in 40% new French oak
