The 2021 harvest season has commenced, and we couldn't be more excited! Each year, we celebrate by pouring a bottle of sparkling wine over our first bin of fruit, and toasting to a great season ahead. It's a wonderful tradition and I always look forward to it.

Both of your wines this September are a blend of blocks from both of our estate vineyards in Sta. Rita Hills. Lincourt wines represent the art of blending to me, and in my opinion, blends allow you to make the most interesting and complete wines. Your first wine comes from the 2019 vintage. Mother nature delivered us a roller coaster of weather, but with it created nuance and diversity of fruit expression that we absolutely love. This 2019 Carol Ann Chardonnay has a little more oak influence than in prior vintages, and happens to be my favorite for its austerity, bright acidity, and rich profile. It's an excellent food-pairing wine, so I recommend savoring it with a cozy butternut squash soup with pine nuts this fall.

The 2017 Annie Dyer Pinot Noir is classic representation of Sta. Rita Hills pinot noir with its incredible notes of pepper and spice. It really showcases how the unique black pepper attribute of Sta. Rita Hills balances so nicely with oak. I pair it with a peppered flat iron steak and enjoy by a cozy fireplace this fall and winter season.

The 2017 Annie Dyer Pinot Noir has that classic black pepper spice of Sta. Rita Hills pinot noir which we love! It is richly decadent, and braced with a bolder oak profile. Big, chewy and powerful, this pinot noir has intense notes of black pepper, blueberry cobbler and rich caramel coffee tones with a spice that lingers on the palate.
