Also "new" is the release of our Estate Rosé! This is the perfect wine to kick-off the spring season and kiss winter goodbye. Our 2019 Estate Cabernet Franc Rosé is clean, crisp and bursting with juicy watermelon and is also available in a show-stopping Hock magnum bottle.

This shipment also includes the popular 2017 Walla Walla Valley Cabernet Sauvignon. All of the Cabernet Sauvignon is from the famed Seven Hills Vineyard, with a little Petit Verdot snuck in there to give it some lift and grit. We've been sourcing from Seven Hills Vineyard for 10 years and it has become a favorite block to walk during late summer/early fall due to its gorgeous landscape and perfectly spaced, well-groomed vines.

For our Red Wine Only club members, you'll be receiving the 2017 Streamlet, the 2nd vintage of this special blend. With equal parts Syrah, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, it highlights some of the best vineyards that Washington has to offer. This blend has hearty, dry tannins and it will age beautifully.

As we head in to the 2020 vintage, we are hoping mother-nature decides to cooperate just a little better this year. We had an abrupt end to the 2019 harvest with frost and freezing temperatures in the beginning of October. But worry not, we had all but one pick of our fruit in, so we are sitting pretty. Whew!

The 2017 Walla Walla Valley Cabernet Sauvignon displays dense black fruit with layered minerality. Dark cherry and flavors of espresso, cola and sandalwood give this wine a robust mouthfeel. Truly a terroir driven wine with refined tannins, it pairs beautifully with beef tenderloin.
