2019 WILLAMETTE VALLEY RESERVE PINOT BLANC

Established in 2003, The Four Graces is committed to making rich, complex wines where the fruit may be elegantly expressed. The winery offers pinot noir as well as small amounts of pinot gris, pinot blanc and chardonnay. The wines are produced from our three estate vineyards — Foley Family Estate, Doe Ridge Estate, our new Van Duzer Corridor vineyard and other top sites in the Willamette Valley. Highly acclaimed, The Four Graces wines are hand-crafted in small lots using traditional techniques coupled with the most modern technology in winemaking.



VINTAGE

The Willamette Valley experienced a mild winter and early spring. The growing season was marked by a combination of heavy precipitation in late June and early July. Steady rains in September and cool weather delayed ripening and made it challenging to determine the optimal time to pick. The pinot blanc for this reserve was harvested in mid September, which is on the early side for this late-ripening varietal. This earlier harvest preserves acidity which provides a counterpoint to the richness in this barrel-aged pinot blanc.

VINEYARD

The grapes for The Four Graces Pinot Blanc come from our very own Foley Family Estate Vineyard as well as Twelve Oaks and Elvenglade Vineyard in the Willamette Valley.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Reserve Pinot Blanc is rich and complex. Aromas of juicy apricot and peach are highlighted by hints of citrus zest. The palate continues with flavors of stonefruits and creamy crème brûlée. The bright acidity is complemented by an integrated and seamless mouthfeel.
