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# Four Graces

2020 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT BLANC

Established in 2003, The Four Graces is committed to making rich, complex wines where the fruit may be elegantly expressed. The winery offers pinot noir as well as small amounts of pinot gris, pinot blanc and chardonnay. The wines are produced from our three estate vineyards — Foley Family Estate, Doe Ridge Estate, our new Van Duzer Corridor vineyard and other top sites in the Willamette Valley. Highly acclaimed, The Four Graces wines are hand-crafted in small lots using traditional techniques coupled with the most modern technology in winemaking.



## VINTAGE

The winter of 2019 and 2020 was relatively mild and dry, which brought a cool spring with few frost events. We experienced rain during flowering, but this resulted in smaller berries and low crop yields. A warm summer was leading up to a small, but promising harvest. Due to high winds on Labor Day and wild fires across Oregon, this made for a very challenging harvest. The Pinot Blanc for this wine weathered the storms of 2020 - and the resulting wine shows surprising depth and finesse.

## VINEYARD

The grapes for The Four Graces Pinot Gris are sourced from our Foley Family Estate vineyard as well as Elvenglade, Twelve Oaks and Huntington Hills vineyards.

## TASTING NOTES

The 2020 Pinot Blanc is bright and refreshing. Aromas of pear and citrus zest mix with floral notes. This medium-bodied wine has a dense and creamy palate ripe with juicy peach and pear flavors. The bright fruit is complemented by refreshing citrus and mineral notes, which linger on the clean finish.
