2024 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT GRIS

Established in 2003, The Four Graces is committed to making rich, complex wines where the fruit may be elegantly expressed. The winery offers pinot noir as well as small amounts of pinot gris, pinot blanc and chardonnay. The wines are produced from our four estate vineyards - Foley Family Estate, Doe Ridge Estate, Weathergage Estate, and Black Walnut in the Willamette Valley. Highly acclaimed, The Four Graces wines are hand-crafted in small lots using traditional techniques coupled with the most modern technology in winemaking.



VINTAGE

The 2024 growing season got off to a slow start with a wet, cool spring. A summer heat wave brought higher than average temperatures to the Willamette Valley and led to some variability in fruit set. Mild temperatures and low precipitation leading up to harvest gave us a long ripening window, allowing flavors to fully develop. Overall, it was a very exciting vintage with excellent fruit quality showing in the wines.

VINEYARD

The fruit for this wine was sourced from the Goschie vineyard near Silverton, Oregon. It was harvested in the early mornings of September 15th and 20th then gently pressed and fermented in stainless steel.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2024 Willamette Valley Pinot Gris offers a fragrant bouquet of ripe pear, white peach, green apple, melon, and flowers. Layers of stone fruit on the palate are lifted by bright acidity, exhibiting remarkable depth and balance.
