Acrobat is Oregon wine made by the King family with the steadfast determination to handcraft wines of the highest quality. Our family appreciates pairing an honest wine with our casual meals and gatherings. This led us to create Acrobat, an effortless selection — a wine that consistently pairs in every way with our lives. Every vintage of Acrobat is artfully crafted in the gorgeous hills and valleys of western Oregon, with an eye on sustainable winemaking practices.

TASTING NOTES

The 2021 Acrobat Rosé has a beautiful, vibrant hue of pale pink. The nose exudes fresh cut strawberries with a hint of lime. The palate is laser focused with bright flavors of fresh strawberries, tropical fruit and lime zest, with a pleasant structure of lively, clean acidity. There is an overall striking balance of fresh fruit and structure that begs to be paired with a variety of food, especially cheese and charcuterie.

WINEMAKING PROCESS

The Pinot Noir for this rosé was harvested earlier in the growing season to retain fresh fruit flavors and bright acidity. The juice was then pressed after minimal skin contact to extract some color and flavor from the Pinot Noir while avoiding bitterness and astringency.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2021 growing season will be remembered in Oregon for record setting heat and dry conditions across the region. The Rogue Valley was especially impacted by the drought conditions, receiving only about 25% of the expected rainfall. Fortunately, grape vines are very resilient. Fruit with high sugars, low disease pressure, and lower than average yield made for wines with ripe, concentrated, and fruity aromatics. The Pinot Noir for this rosé was some of the first fruit harvested this vintage, marking the beginning of an early and high quality harvest.
