Mordecai is the wine that we have the broadest set of components to work with and the widest bullseye to shoot for when blending. All of the elements of this wine are made with our house philosophy (think bright flavors, focus, energy, good with food), with the overreaching mandate that it is absolutley delicious. Thus, each year we set out to make a medium plus bodied red that you could put on the table or counter anywhere at anytime and make everybody happy.



The very rough and unscientific formula is this: about a third Bordeaux varieties, about a third Rhône varieties, and about a third other varieties dominated by Petite Sirah and Merlot with a bit of this or that peppered in.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

25% Petite Sirah, 23% Merlot, 13% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Petit Verdot, 8% Syrah, 6% Mourvedre, 5% Malbec, 4% Grenache, 4% Tannat, 3% Zinfadel

VINEYARDS

78% Sonoma County, 18% North Coast, 4% Mendocino County

WINEMAKING

Aging for 20 months- 20% new French oak barrels

TASTING

An enticing nose of of spice, black tea and candied bacon covered in fudge. On the palate it is a mouthwatering mélange of blue fruit flavors backed by bright balanced acid, rustic leather tannins and meaty tones giving way to a smooth, milk chocolate finish.
