2025 DUNDEE HILLS RESERVE ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

Established in 2003, The Four Graces is committed to making rich, complex wines where the fruit may be elegantly expressed. The winery offers pinot noir as well as small amounts of pinot gris, pinot blanc and chardonnay. The wines are produced from our four estate vineyards - Foley Family Estate, Doe Ridge Estate, Weathergag Estate and Black Walnut Estate in the Willamette Valley. Highly acclaimed, The Four Graces wines are hand-crafted in small lots using traditional techniques coupled with the most modern technology in winemaking.



VINTAGE

The 2025 Willamette Valley wine grape vintage was defined by an early and rapid growing season with warm, dry conditions that advanced budbreak, bloom, and ripening ahead of historical norms. A heatwave in August was followed by moderate temperatures in September that provided ideal conditions for ripening before harvest. Overall, fruit quality was excellent, producing small berries with concentrated, balanced fruit flavors.

VINEYARD

We sourced the Dundee Hills Rosé solely from our Black Walnut Estate vineyard. One of the highest elevation vineyards in the Dundee Hills, the fruit tends to ripen more slowly and retains more natural acidity.

TASTING NOTES

The 2025 Dundee Hills growing season was warm, dry, and marked by an early bloom followed by a late-summer heat wave that briefly hit 100°F. These conditions accelerated ripening in late August and led to one of the earliest harvests on records. Despite the heat, the fruit retained bright natural acidity, and a balanced structure. 2025 also marked the 20th anniversary of the Dundee Hills AVA.
