2024 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR

Established in 2003, The Four Graces is committed to making rich, complex wines where the fruit may be elegantly expressed. The winery offers pinot noir as well as small amounts of pinot gris, pinot blanc and chardonnay. The wines are produced from our four estate vineyards - Foley Family Estate, Doe Ridge Estate, Weathergage Estate, and Black Walnut Estate. Highly acclaimed, The Four graces wines are hand-crafted in small lots using traditional techniques coupled with the most modern technology in winemaking.



VINTAGE

The 2024 growing season got off to a slow start with a wet, cool spring. A summer heat wave brought higher than average temperatures to the Willamette Valley and led to some variability in fruit set. Mild temperatures and low precipitation leading up to harvest gave us a long ripening window, allowing flavors to fully develop. Overall, it was a very exciting vintage with excellent fruit quality showing in the wines.

VINEYARD

The fruit for this wine was sourced from our estate vineyards: Foley Family and Black Walnut in the Dundee Hills AVA, Doe Ridge in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, and Weathergage in the Van Duzer Corridor AVA; as well as fruit from select sites throughout the Willamette Valley AVA.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2024 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir opens with a beautiful bouquet of huckleberry, dried cherry, orange peel, clove, cedar, and mocha. On the palate, fine tannin provides support to flavors of pomegranate and tart strawberry. Persistent balanced acidity carries the wine through the finish. Serve with pork tenderloin, mushroom risotto, or roasted chicken.
