2018 ROTH ESTATE SONOMA COUNTY SAUVIGNON BLANC

ROTH ESTATE IS COMMITTED TO MAKING WINES WITH THE TRUEST AND BEST EXPRESSION OF THE DIVERSE AND IDYLIC GROWING CONDITIONS IN SONOMA COUNTY. OUR 2018 SAUVIGNON BLANC OPENS WITH VIBRANT CITRUS FLAVORS THAT MELD TOGETHER WITH SUBTLE NOTES OF JASMINE AND LEMONGRASS TO CREATE A REFRESHING FINISH WITH BALANCED MINERALITY. THIS WINE PAIRS WONDERFULLY WITH GOAT CHEESE, GRILLED ARTICHOKE, SEAFOOD OR PESTO PASTAS.



WINERY BACKGROUND

Roth Estate is a family-owned winery dedicated to crafting full-flavored wines grown in exemplary Sonoma County vineyards. Beginning in 2001, Roth committed to producing classic Bordeaux varietals in Alexander Valley. A decade later the winery expanded its wine making to include cool-climate varietals from the Sonoma Coast.

2018 VITAGE

The majority of fruit for our 2018 Sonoma County Sauvignon Blanc was sourced from our sister property, Chalk Hill Estate. The 2018 growing season was one of the most consistent in recent memory. These Sauvignon Blanc grapes were harvested August 30 - October 8, 2018 and then fermented in stainless steel tanks and French oak barrels.
