

2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MALLACOMES RANCH Knights Valley | Sonoma County

Created in 1973 from a family's dream to build a world-class winery in the heart of Sonoma County, Chateau St. Jean has evolved through the years to become a shining example of a fine wine estate with European style. Balanced and elegant wines are the hallmark of Chateau St. Jean. Our single vineyard wines showcase and celebrate Sonoma's distinctive, world-class growing regions.

VINEYARDS

The fruit was selected from a focused section of our Knights Valley Mallacomes Ranch vineyard that produces exceptional fruit.

WINEMAKING

After fermentation in stainless steel, the wine was barreled to French oak, with about 7% in new oak. Following aging for 20 months in barrel, the lots were blended and bottled before allowing the wine to rest for another nine months prior to release.

VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season started later than usual in many California wine regions. A wet spring followed by cool temperatures allowed the grapes to mature gradually. Cool temperatures continued throughout the growing season resulting in longer hang time and lower sugar yields. Vintners are praising the full flavors, fresh acidity and superb balance of the 2019 vintage.

TASTING NOTES

Enticing purple hues in the glass give way to aromas of dark cherry, Madagascar vanilla, notes of mocha, caramel, and baking spices. This wine is dense, yet gracefully structured with balanced acidity. Abundant dark fruit and gentle brown sugar notes flow through the long finish. A worthy illustration of all the Knights Valley has to offer.
