VINTAGE

The winter of 2020-2021 had minimal rainfall and mild temperatures leading to drought conditions in Sonoma County. With warmer than average winter and spring, budbreak was 2 weeks ahead of average. Summer was warm and dry, with a few short heat spikes. The warm weather resulted in beautifully ripened fruit for the red wine harvest.

VINEYARDS & WINEMAKING

Fruit for this wine was sourced from sustainably farmed vineyards with alluvial, sandy, and well-drained soils throughout Sonoma County, including Tannat from the Foley Sonoma estate vineyards. After harvest the fruit was fermented in stainless steel tanks and then racked to French oak barrels (II% new) for I9 months prior to bottling.

TASTING NOTES

One of our most distinctive wines aromatically, the 2021 Estate Tannat opens with lush aromatics of black cherry jam, cola, a hint of bacon, and nutmeg spice. The palate is full-bodied with dark raspberry, red plum, and leather framed by popping acidity that leads to a satisfying finish.
