TROPICAL AROMAS OF WHITE FLOWER, CITRUS, MANGO AND HONEYDEW MELON FILL THE NOSE UPON OPENING OUR 2021 PROPRIETARY WHITE WINE. THESE AROMAS CONTINUE ONTO THE PALATE, WITH ADDITIONAL NOTES OF JUICY GRAPEFRUIT, MEYER LEMON AND A SUBTLE MINERALITY. THIS IS A WELL-ROUNDED WINE WITH A RICH TEXTURE AND LINGERING SMOOTH FINISH.

VINTAGE

The winter of 2020-2021 had minimal rainfall and mild temperatures leading to drought conditions throughout California's North Coast. With a warmer than average winter and spring, budbreak was two weeks ahead of normal. Summer was warm and dry, with a few short heat spikes. The warm weather resulted in beautifully ripened fruit and a fairly early harvest.

VINEYARDS & WINEMAKING

Our Proprietary White Wine is a Bordeaux style blend made primarily of Sauvignon Gris, which is a slightly fuller bodied and richer wine than its close relative, Sauvignon Blanc. The fruit was sourced from our estate vineyard in Russian River Valley, known for its cool, foggy climate that sweeps in from the Pacific Ocean and its alluvial soils, this river valley is an idyllic site for growing Sauvignon Gris and Sauvignon Blanc.
