Established in 2003, The Four Graces is committed to making rich, complex wines where the fruit may be elegantly expressed. The winery offers pinot noir as well as small amounts of pinot gris, pinot blanc and chardonnay. The wines are produced from our three estate vineyards - Foley Family Estate, Doe Ridge Estate, Weathergage Estate and other top sites in the Willamette Valley. Highly acclaimed, The Four graces wines are hand-crafted in small lots using traditional techniques coupled with the most modern technology in winemaking.



VINTAGE

The 2024 growing season got off to a slow start with a wet, cool spring. A summer heat wave brought higher than average temperatures to the Willamette Valley and led to some variability in fruit set. Mild temperatures and low precipitation leading up to harvest gave us a long ripening window, allowing flavors to fully develop. Overall, it was a very exciting vintage with excellent fruit quality showing in the wines.

VINEYARD

2024 is the first year we sourced the Dundee Hills Rosé solely from our Black Walnut Estate vineyard. One of the highest elevation vineyards in the Dundee Hills, the fruit tends to ripen more slowly and retains more natural acidity.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2024 Dundee Hills Reserve Rosé of Pinot Noir is the perfect spring or summertime wine. Aromas of wild strawberry, guava, linalool, and citrus zest lead to a beautifully balanced palate. Fresh and poised, this wine delivers bright acidity harmoniously integrated in the plush mouthfeel. This wine is an excellent apéritif, or served with summer salads, mild cheeses, and charcuterie.
