Our 2023 Proprietary White Wine opens with a bouquet of grapefruit, HONEYSUCKLE, AND WHITE PEACH. THE PALATE EXHIBITS A BEAUTIFUL COMPILATION OF MELON AND FRESH HERBS WITH A DISTINCT MINERALITY. Enjoy this fresh and delicious wine with barbequed oysters or GARLIC PRAWNS.

VINTAGE

The winter of 2022-2023 saw record rainfall, ending years of drought conditions throughout Sonoma County. With below average temperatures in winter and spring, budbreak was significantly delayed. Continued cool weather through summer led to harvest beginning 2 weeks later than average. This gave the grapes ample time to hang on the vine which helped develop full flavors while maintaining vibrant acidity.

VINEYARDS & WINEMAKING

The 2023 vintage of Proprietary White Wine is a blend of 75% Sauvignon Gris and 25% Sauvignon Blanc. The fruit was sourced from our estate vineyard in Russian River Valley, known for its cool, foggy climate that sweeps in from the Pacific Ocean and its alluvial soils, this river valley is an idyllic site for growing Sauvignon Gris and Sauvignon Blanc.
