



2025 NAPA VALLEY ROSÉ WINE



VINEYARD

The fruit for this wine was sourced from one of our neighboring estates in Rutherford. This sub-appellation is defined by its iconic “Rutherford Dust”—gravelly, well-drained soils that impart a signature minerality and supple tannins. In Rutherford’s warm Mediterranean climate, Petite Sirah thrives, soaking up intense sun to achieve full phenolic ripeness while maintaining incredible structure.

VINTAGE

Following a winter of replenishing rains, Napa Valley experienced its coolest growing season in over 65 years. This historic moderation allowed the fruit to reach full flavor and color maturity at lower sugar levels, preserving delicate aromatics and a sophisticated, lower-alcohol profile. With only eight days reaching above 95°F, we maintained exceptional freshness through an unhurried, two-month harvest, crafting a Rosé of rare poise and elegant restraint.

TASTING NOTES

The 2025 Silverado Rosé opens with an enchanting bouquet of strawberries and cream, accented by red cherries, pluot, and a whisper of light plum and violet. On the palate, this wine is delicate and bright, bursting with fresh red berries and the snap of crisp Pink Lady apples. A refreshing zestiness and vibrant acidity carry through to the finish, making every sip as lively as it is elegant.
