Founded in 1972, Firestone was the first major estate winery to sink roots in Santa Barbara County. The winery's proximity to the Pacific Ocean, a mere 26 miles to the west, ensures a relatively mild and arid climate throughout the year, making it an ideal setting for our estate vineyards planted to Bordeaux, Rhône and Burgundian varieties.

VINEYARDS The Santa Ynez Valley is located just two hours north of Los Angeles and five hours south of San Francisco, adjacent the cold Pacific Ocean. With the greatest concentration of wineries in Santa Barbara County - roughly 18% of its total land planted to vineyards - it is among the favorite weekend destinations for wine aficionados in the Central Coast region.

VINTAGE The 2025 vintage in Santa Ynez Valley was defined by patience, vigilance, and extraordinary restraint. A record-breaking cool season led to a historic late harvest, producing elegant, nuanced wines with vibrant acidity and naturally lower alcohol.

WINEMAKER NOTES The 2025 Santa Ynez Valley Rosé opens with an elegant and expressive nose defined by perfumed rose petals and ripe watermelon. The palate is beautifully textured and inviting, offering lush flavors of strawberries and cream accented by candied cherries and a delicate hint of toasted meringue. This versatile wine is the perfect partner for savory and sweet Char Siu, as its bright fruit and creamy finish seamlessly complement the dish's rich, glazed flavors.
