VINTAGE

The 2024 white wine harvest in Russian River Valley was marked by favorable conditions leading to high-quality fruit. The growing season began with abundant winter rainfall, which provided essential soil moisture and supported healthy vine development. A mild winter and spring followed and helped preserve acidity, resulting in white wines with strong varietal character and pronounced aromatics.

VINEYARD

The fruit for the 2024 Pinot Grigio was sourced from the Chalk Hill and Storey Creek vineyards.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were hand picked at night in half-ton macrobins and brought to the winery. They were gently whole-cluster pressed, cold-settled, then racked to a stainless steel tank where the wine underwent primary fermentation. It aged for 8 months in 85% stainless steel and 15% neutral oak before bottling on May 7, 2025.

TASTING NOTES

This wine is full and bright, offering abundant tropical notes of pineapple, guava, and mango with notes of strawberry and lemon. Wet sea-stone minerality lingers on the finish. Enjoy with fried fish tacos, or a goat cheese and strawberry salad.
