A fine wine estate with European style, we are proud to produce balanced and elegant wines, a hallmark of Chateau St. Jean. Our single-vineyard and blend expressions celebrate Sonoma County's distinctive, world-class growing region, and the special vineyard sites in which our grapes are grown.

VINEYARDS

Oak Hill vineyard is located in the Chalk Hill sub-appellation in the northeast corner of the Russian River Valley AVA. It has a warmer climate and less fog than typically characterizes the region, with notably hot, dry summers and cool, moist winters.

VINTAGE

Significant rainfall and moderate temperatures prolonged fruit development, yielding lower sugar levels and beautifully balanced, fresh character across all varietals.

WINEMAKING

The fruit for this wine is hand-picked and whole-cluster pressed prior to racking and fermentation in stainless steel tanks. This wine does not undergo malolactic fermentation in order to retain its bright flavors and crisp acidity.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2023 Oak Hill Sauvignon Blanc is fresh and clean, with aromas of lemon-lime, green melon, and honey. The palate is crisp, offering white peach flavors layered with lime zest and refreshing minerality. This wine's light profile makes it excellent for sipping on its own or paired with crab gazpacho, muscles, or smoked salmon
