2023 WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT GRIS

Established in 2003, The Four Graces is committed to making rich, complex wines where the fruit may be elegantly expressed. The winery offers pinot noir as well as small amounts of pinot gris, pinot blanc and chardonnay. The wines are produced from our three estate vineyards — Foley Family Estate, Doe Ridge Estate, Weathergage Estate and other top sites in the Willamette Valley. Highly acclaimed, The Four Graces wines are hand-crafted in small lots using traditional techniques coupled with the most modern technology in winemaking.



VINTAGE

The 2023 growing season got off to a slow start and there were concerns of a very late vintage. Unusually warm weather in April and May caused rapid vine growth, catching up to previous vintages. Heat spikes in August led to some sunburn and continued the warming trend of the season. 2023 ended up being one of the warmest and earliest seasons on record.

VINEYARD

The fruit, which is sourced from our estate vineyards in the Van Duzer Corridor and the Dundee Hills AVA's, as well as Goschie vineyard near Silverton, OR, was harvested in the early morning of September 15th, gently pressed, and fermented in stainless steel.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2023 Pinot Gris has beautiful aromas of ripe pear, crispin apple, melon, and floral notes. The palate continues in this medium-bodied wine with layers of tropical fruit, which exhibits depth and balance.
