Our roots are in Sonoma County. We have made wines from the region's diverse vineyards for over 50 years, starting in 1973. A fine wine estate with European style, we are proud to produce balanced and elegant wines, a hallmark of Chateau St. Jean. Our single-vineyard and blend expressions celebrate Sonoma County's distinctive, world-class growing region, and the special vineyard sites in which our grapes are grown.

VINEYARDS

Grapes for this wine were selected from premium, cool-climate vineyards from which we've sourced fruit for over a decade. Tucked away in the southern edge of Sonoma County near the San Pablo Bay, the vineyards' topography is ideally suited for concentrated Pinot Noir and Chardonnay with good acid retention, with its cool, maritime-influenced climate and rocky, volcanic soils.

VINTAGE

The 2020 Carneros vintage was excellent for Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Flavors matured early resulting in beautiful complexity for sparkling wines.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2020 Blanc de Noirs is crisp and clean with bright citrus, Melipona honey, and floral notes coupled with subtle croissant and fine mousse characters. Pair with arugula salad with goat cheese, almonds, and Champagne vinaigrette or seared scallops with beurre blanc.
