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VINYARDS & WINEMAKING

Our Sangiovese is sourced from our neighbors in the Alexander Valley. David Fanucchi planted this block on the hillside below his childhood home nearly a century ago, allowing for excellent drainage and sun exposure. This east-west vineyard benefits from even ripening and balanced flavors. Following harvest, the grapes were fermented in stainless steel tanks and then racked to French oak barrels. After aging for 15 months with regular lees stirring, the wine was bottled.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2019 Fanucchi Ranch Sangiovese is supple and approachable. Beautiful notes of bright raspberry, potpourri, and cherry cola carry the palate on this rare wine. Medium bodied with bright acidity and smooth round tannins coat the palate, getting you ready for the next sip. We make a very limited amount of this wine, so it is very special to savor with friends and family.
