## 2021 ACROBAT CHARDONNAY OREGON

Acrobat wines are the result of determination to handcraft Oregon Pinot Noir and Pinot Gris of the highest quality. At the heart of these wines is the love of pairing an honest wine with casual meals and gatherings. Acrobat should always be an effortless selection—a wine that consistenly pairs in every way with our lives. Acrobat is artfully crafted in the gorgeous hills and valleys of western Oregon, with an eye on sustainable winemaking practices.

## TASTING NOTES

Fields of exuberant yellow straw come to mind when describing this chardonnay's color. On the nose, a bouquet of notes ranging from ripe peach and pear, to bright lemon and vanilla, shine through. A clean and refined entrance gives way to layers of lemon zest, pear and creamy vanilla on the mid-palate. The medium-long finish is fresh and held together by lively acidity.

## WINEMAKING PROCESS

The 2021 vintage was 100% aged in French oak barrels and completed malolactic fermentation. This wine was inoculated with a Burgundian isolate of yeast to enhance the mouthfeel and preserve the beautiful aromatics.

## VINTAGE NOTES

The 2021 growing season will be remembered in Oregon for record setting heat and dry conditions across the region. The Chardonnay for the 2021 vintage was sourced from the Naumes Vineyard in the Rogue Valley and the Blue Heron and Carlow Vineyards in Umpqua Valley. These regions had one of its earliest harvests on record in early and late September. Fruit with high sugars, low disease pressure, and lower than average yields made for concentrated wines with ripe and fruity aromatics.
